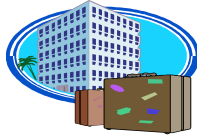

### From the West (Windsor)

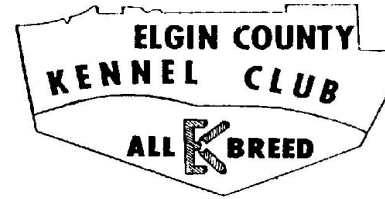

**Junior Handling Competition—Sponsored by Treasure Coast**

**Saturday January 16 2010**

**Junior handling Zone rep Nelly Bennett**

1. Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Show Secretary and must include the following:
  - a) Name of Club and date of event
  - b) Name, address, telephone number, date of birth, signature of Junior handler
  - c) class entered, breed & catalogue number of dog to be handled
2. A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the show, provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so
3. The Junior Handler will wear the armband number assigned to the dog for the show
4. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed
5. Dogs being used in competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler. If the Junior Handler cannot lift the dog, it is not appropriate in size for the competitor

**CLASSES OFFERED AT THIS SHOW**

**Junior Novice**

This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

**Junior Open**

This class is for handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 first places with competition.

**Intermediate Novice Class**

This class is for handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

**Intermediate Open Class**

This class is for handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 first places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

**Senior Novice Class**

This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

**Senior Open Class**

This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

**The Best Junior Handler Overall will have their name engraved on the NANCY MCPHEE Memorial Trophy. In addition a suitable keeper trophy, and rosette will be awarded to the Best Junior Handler Overall**

The show precincts will be the inside of the Canada Building and areas immediately adjacent to the building. The Canada Building will be open from 4:30 pm to 10:00 pm for the convenience of exhibitors on January 14th. The building will be open each morning at 7:00 am and will close each evening at 10:00 pm.

**Grooming & Crating**

Do not Exercise Dogs outside the Show Building on the Grass, Sidewalks or paved parking area. Crating will be allowed in designated areas only, and crates should be stacked. Additional Crating Space inside the building may NOT be reserved by roping off, placing cones, chairs, tables equipment or any other means. The Club reserves the right to restrict the number of grooming tables and to rearrange the grooming area and setups as required to provide for the safety and convenience of all exhibitors. This may include the moving of crates, tables and other equipment.

Exhibitors & Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions around their carting areas. NO private exercise pens will allowed up during show hours. Public exercise pens will be provided and must be attended by the owner or handler while in use. Ringside chairs are NOT to be taken to the grooming area. Your co-operation is essential

## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under CKC Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided as follows;

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

- Includes dog awarded WINNERS
- In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for Championship points.
- To determine the number of Championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winner, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex, and the consult the schedule set forth above.
- In addition to the Championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level
- No dog may be credited with more than 5 points in a single show

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

- All communication regarding entries should be addressed to the Show Secretary
- Entries without a fee will not be accepted
- Acknowledgement of entries with a Judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after the closing date
- Make all cheques payable to the show giving club
- The Club and Canine Show Services 2000 Inc will not be responsible for cash sent through the mail
- Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$25 will be added by Canine Show Services 2000 Inc in addition to any bank charges for each returned cheque.
- There is no refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts of God, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries shall be made
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing time is prohibited
- The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of Judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/Agents are responsible to have their dogs present when their classes are called to be judged
- Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy. If space is at a premium, exhibitors must remove exercise pens if requested by the Show Superintendent

The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules

Attention Foreign Exhibitors : Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheque "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by banks. To simplify the process we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.
